Race4Chase Kid's Triathlon Program is aimed to provide children with a safe, healthy, non-competitive environment to discover the sport of triathlon. Designed as a six-week goal oriented summer program, the program provides kids with expert instruction in swimming, cycling, running, strength training and flexibility, and also teaches them the fundamentals of good nutrition under the supportive guidance of coaches, lifeguards and instructors. At the culmination of the training camp, all of the youth athletes come together to compete in a USAT-sanctioned triathlon race.

Application due no later than April 1st. Limited enrollment – applications will be evaluated and selected based on first time registration, a demonstration of need, and those indicating a sincere desire to participate for the complete duration of the program.
